Parade Entry Details

Eligibility

- Most Parade Homes are brand new homes that have not yet been lived in, but must have been completed after June 1, 2025 and can't have been shown in a previous Parade of Homes.
- New homes that have been occupied are now eligible for entry into the Parade of Homes, subject to approval from the Parade of Homes Committee and with all conditions outlined in the homeowner agreement met. New homes must have been completed after June 1, 2025.
- Remodeling: Construction OR Remodeling: Cosmestic projects are eligible for entry.
- Remodeling: Construction Remodeling projects completed by a Builder member with a Dwelling Contractor Qualifier license, completed after June 1, 2025; have a minimum value of \$20,000; and showcase a change in shape, style, form, or function of a residence or outdoor living space.
- Remodeling: Cosmetic Projects that showcase landscaping, outdoor living spaces, re-design or any project that changes the shape, style, or function of a space that does not require pulling a building permit. Projects must have been completed after June 1, 2025 and have a minimum value of \$20,000.
- All entered homes must be showcased in-person.
 Virtual entries will no longer be included in the event.

Be the Premiere Home - Host the Premiere Night!

Thursday, June 4, 2026

Each year a Parade Home(s) is selected to host the member Premiere night. The Premiere night kicks off the Parade of Homes the Thursday before the Parade opens for all CVHBA members and the host's guests. The Premiere night typically has around 250 people in attendance.

Why host the Premiere? This is a unique opportunity for a builder to debut his/her home (or development) to the CVHBA membership and gain some extra awareness with the public. Participation Agreement

(Parade). The Participant agrees that the house en	tered in said Parade shall conform to	the rules and regulations established by the CVHBA.
All homes entered in the Parade must comply at all	times with OSHA safety standards. T	he CVHBA agrees to promote the Parade and to insure
public attendance to the greatest extent possible. A	Il methods of the 2026 Parade promo	tions shall be determined by the CVHBA Staff and
Parade of Homes Committee.		

Membership: In order to be eligible to participate in the Parade, the Participant shall be a member of the CVHBA as of January 1st, 2026, as defined in the CVHBA bylaws, and in good standing with the CVHBA. Participant shall not be in a state of suspension, be delinquent in dues, or other monetary obligations to the CVHBA from the time of signing the Participation Agreement through the Parade. The CVHBA Executive Committee has the right to waive the membership date requirement in its sole discretion.

New Home Eligibility: To be eligible for inclusion as a new home in the 2026 Parade of Homes, the home must be a new construction home completed after June 1, 2025; and must not have been a part of any previous Parade of Homes. Any new home that is custom-built will need to have the Homeowner Agreement submitted with the Parade Entry Information. Any home sold during the construction process will need a Homeowner Agreement submitted after the sale of the home. All new homes must have a contractor with a Dwelling Contractor Qualifier license.

A new home may be eligible to be included in the Parade of Homes if it has been occupied before the Parade of Homes, subject to approval by the Parade of Homes Committee, if the following conditions are met: 1) the homeowner must sign an agreement that outlines the expectations of the homeowner; 2) the Participant must agree to take on the responsibility of ensuring the home is clean, tidy and in Parade Home shape before and during the event; and 3) the Participant must protect the homeowner's personal belongings by ensuring staff coverage throughout the home (contact the CVHBA for more details and suggestions). The Parade of Homes Committee will meet with any Participants requesting to enter a home that has been occupied before the Parade of Homes and will determine if the home is eligible for entry into the Parade of Homes based upon the member's adherence to the requirements listed.

Remodel Eligibility: Remodeling projects must have been completed after June 1, 2025 and have a minimum value of \$20,000. The project entered showcases a change in shape, style, form, or function of a residence or outdoor living space. A Home Owner Agreement must be signed and submitted with the entry form and participation agreement in order for a Remodeled Home to be eligible for inclusion in the Parade of Homes. The Remodeling Construction category is for builders with a Dwelling Contractor Qualifier license and should be used for any project requiring a building permit. The Remodeling Cosmetic category is for CVHBA Members who do not have a Dwelling Contractor license and are completing projects that do not require building permits such as: outdoor living spaces, exterior remodeling, interior design, kitchen / bathrooms that are a design update, etc.

<u>Date & Hours of Parade:</u> The Parade will operate June 6 through June 13, 2026, or such other dates established by the CVHBA Board of Directors. Open hours for the public shall be 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Saturdays & Sundays and 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Remodeling entries will be open June 6 through June 8, 2026 during regular open hours. These hours are subject to change upon recommendation of the Parade Committee and approval by the Board of Directors. Participant agrees that if Parade Home is not open during the official open hours of the Parade, it shall be the right of CVHBA to remove the Parade Home from participation in the Parade. The Parade Home must be staffed during all open hours and the Participant agrees to take sole responsibility for opening and staffing the parade home. During the Parade, Parade Home's shall only be open during regular event days and hours. The Parade Home must also be available for viewing for any CVHBA scheduled activities during the week of the Parade of Homes (i.e. member bus tour, school tours, etc). Any additional activities will be coordinated with the Participant.

Completed Home: All Parade Homes (new homes and remodels) must be 100% complete and ready for occupancy by Thursday.

June 4 and it must be staged by Friday. June 5. For new homes, a completed home includes: all landscaping (rock &/or mulch beds, trees, shrubs, etc); the yard is seeded or sod is laid; driveway & sidewalks completed; exterior of house completed; all hard surfaced flooring, tile & carpeting installed and finished; plumbing fixtures installed; heating and electrical complete; cabinetry & countertops completed and installed with hardware; appliances installed; staircases & railings complete; trim work complete; and staged furnishings in at least the living room, dining room, and master bedroom. Note: the basement is not required to be finished for inclusion in the Parade. For remodeled homes, a completed home means that all areas of the remodeling project are complete.

All construction debris should be properly disposed of before the Parade opens. The Executive Officer and the Parade Chair(s) must sign off on the final inspection before the house will be allowed to be opened for the Parade of Homes. In the occurrence that a house does not pass final inspection, the Executive Officer and Parade Chair(s) have the right to delay the opening of the home until it passes final inspection. Homes that are not complete, as defined above, at the time of the Parade of Homes will result in the surrendering of the full deposit and may result in the Board of Directors refusing a Participant entry into future years' Parade of Homes.

<u>Virtual Entries</u>: Virtual entries will not be permitted for the 2026 Parade of Homes. All new homes and remodeling projects must be available to tour in person.

Inspections: The Parade of Homes Committee and Executive Officer will conduct at least one inspection of each house within two weeks of the start of the Parade of Homes. Additional inspections may be scheduled at the discretion of the Executive Officer and Parade Chair(s). It is the responsibility of the Participant to ensure the inspectors have access to enter the Parade Home on inspection days. Failure to provide entry to the Parade Home will result in loss of deposit (\$100) and may result in the Parade Home being delayed in opening. New Homes will have a scheduled inspection day and Remodel Entries will need to schedule an inspection at at time that works with the homeowner. Any new homes that have been occupied before the Parade of Homes will need an inspection on Friday, June 5 to ensure the home is ready for the Parade of Homes.

Parade Participant Meetings: The Participant is required to attend Parade Participant Meetings scheduled to convey important information and obtain feedback as to the planning of the Parade. The Participant shall attend and participate in all Parade Participant meetings, this includes

two (2) meetings prior to the Parade and one (1) wrap-up meeting. If Participant is absent from two (2) or more meetings, the Board of Directors can take disciplinary action which may include suspension from future years' Parade of Homes. Meeting dates are published in the Parade packet and are subject to change with at least two (2) week's notice.

<u>Parade of Homes Committee</u>: A Parade of Homes Committee composed of Builder and Associate members will work on the planning of the Parade. The Committee will solicit feedback from the Participants during Parade Participant meetings and Participants in the Parade are welcome to join the committee and participate in the planning of the event.

Attendance at Premiere: The Participant agrees to have a representative attend the Parade of Homes Premiere event on Thursday, June 4, 2026.

<u>Security:</u> Participant shall be solely responsible for security of the Parade Home and property, both during construction and while used as a Parade Home. For Remodel Entries, the Participant is responsible for blocking off areas of the home not included in the Parade and is expected to have staff in each area of the remodel to ensure safety and security of the owner's belongings.

Shoe Covers: Everyone visiting a Parade Home must wear shoe covers. Each Participant will receive shoe covers to provide participants and is asked to ensure those entering the Parade Home are wearing shoe covers.

<u>Lawn Maintenance & Sprinkling:</u> Lawn maintenance and irrigation of lawns, trees, and shrubs shall not interfere with the customer experience. Participant and trade contractors shall be aware of municipal restrictions such as water usage limits.

<u>Portable Toilets:</u> The CVHBA will make all efforts to provide one sponsored portable toilet per parade home that is to be used by parade goers and volunteers. The portable toilet provided by CVHBA is only for use for Parade goers, volunteers, and builders during the official Parade of Homes hours. The CVHBA or the Portable Toilet provider has the right to charge the Participant if the toilet is being used for construction and requires additional maintenance. The CVHBA reserves the right to not offer this service during the Parade if conditions prohibit the providing of a portable toilet.

Early Completion & Display: If a home is finished before the Parade, the home may be available for private showings. A Parade Home may be available for public showings before the Parade of Homes (i.e. open houses or model home) ONLY in the instance where there is no reference to the home being included in the Parade of Homes in any marketing for the home. No public showings are allowed of Parade Homes from June 5 thorugh June 14, 2026; this includes open houses published on the MLS. No open houses can be held from June 5 through June 14, 2026. After June 14, 2026, then the Parade Home can be used for any public showings, open houses, etc with no restrictions.

Insurance: The Participant shall obtain and furnish to the CVHBA a Certificate of Insurance listing the parade home address, naming the Chippewa Valley Home Builders Association as an additional insured, and insuring bodily injury of at least \$500,000 and property damage limits of \$50,000 or minimum required by law.

<u>Withdrawal from the Parade</u>: In the occurrence where a home needs to be withdrawn from the Parade, the full amount of the entry fee and deposit will be refunded until March 31, 2026. Any withdrawals after March 31st, 2026 the Participant will forfeit the entry fee. Any withdrawals after April 14, 2026 and the Participant will also forfeit the full deposit.

<u>Use of CVHBA Members, Signage & Marketing During the Parade:</u> CVHBA encourages Participants to utilize CVHBA member suppliers and subcontractors for the Parade Homes. Many of the CVHBA members give discounts and special benefits for Parade Homes. *Participants may only display signage that promotes CVHBA members.* Participants can hand out business cards of non-members who provided work or supplies to the Parade Home, but no printed information larger than a business card (2" x 3.5") can be distributed and non-member information cannot be displayed. It is the Participant's responsibility to ensure compliance by all of employees and subcontractors. The CVHBA will provide the Participant with a written notification for any signage violations and signage must be removed before the start of Parade of Homes on the following day. *The deposit shall be withheld as outlined on Deposit Withholding sheet if signage reappears after the warning. If signage violations are not corrected, the Board of Directors has the right to refuse a Member entry into future years' Parade of Homes.*

The CVHBA will provide Parade of Homes branded signs for use during the Parade to designate the Parade Home site. All CVHBA provided signs must be displayed at each Parade Home. The Participant also has the right to display their own sign with their logo and information. If the Parade Home is listed with a realtor, the standard and expected realtor listing sign is allowed in the front yard and the house spec sheet can be displayed in the Parade Home. If the realtor is not a member of the CVHBA, no additional signage or marketing materials is allowed on the property.

Any contractors who are working at the Parade Home to talk about and promote their products or services <u>must be a CVHBA member</u>. Volunteers scanning and selling tickets do not need to be a member, however anyone who is at the Parade Home for the purpose of talking about products/services used in the home or selling products/services must be representing a CVHBA member business.

<u>Ticket Sales:</u> The Participant is responsible for all ticket sales at the Parade Home during the Parade. The Participant assumes all responsibilities for the tickets, cash and ticketing supplies provided at the start of the Parade and is expected to train any volunteers handling ticketing during the Parade. The Participant or a representative is responsible for following all ticketing procedures established by the CVHBA and ensuring accurate tracking and money handling is maintained throughout the Parade of Homes. *Any discrepancies in ticket sales will be charged to the Participant.*

<u>Supplies and Ticket Return:</u> All provided Parade supplies, remaining tickets, and ticket money must be *returned to the CVHBA office no later than 4:00pm on the Monday following the close of the Parade of Homes.* Remodel Entries are expected to return all supplies on Tuesday, after the close of the Remodel entries.

Images, Video & Marketing of Parade Homes: The Participant agrees to allow CVHBA and it's hired contractors to take photographs and video of the Parade Home. These are available to the Participant upon request for their own promotional purposes. CVHBA agrees that any photos and/or videos of Parade Homes used in future promotions or marketing will give credit to the Participant. The Participant agrees that photos and/or videos of the Parade Home may be used for promotion by the CVHBA and that the CVHBA has full rights to use photos and videos, including any purchased by the Participant through the CVHBA Contractor, in promotion of the Parade and general marketing. If the Parade Home is owned at the time of the Parade, the Customer Parade Home Waiver must be signed acknowledging the customer is aware of the marketing 8

rights of the CVHBA.

<u>Parade Book & Information Accuracy</u>: All Participant will receive a two-page listing in the Home Inspirations Parade of Homes issue and a listing on the web-based Parade directory. All information and materials for inclusion in the Parade Book and webpage must be received by April 3, 2026: written description of entry, price, high quality digital color rendering, floor plan (optional), directions from nearest major highway, updated list of suppliers and subcontractors, logo in .jpg or .png format, and photo of builder (optional) in .jpg or .png format. Failure to provide all required information by the deadline will result in a loss of the deposit.

Each Participant will receive a proof prior to printing and is responsible for approving the proof before the print deadline. If approval is not given, it is assumed that the information is accurate and the Parade Book will be printed accordingly. Best efforts by the CVHBA will be made to ensure accurate information in all Parade related publications; however, all Participants are responsible for ensuring accurate information is provided and will hold the CVHBA harmless in the event that errors or omissions occur.
